# INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

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It is strongly recommended that you close all programs before beginning the installation of any software on your computer. This includes any screen savers and anti-virus software which may interfere with the installation process. If you downloaded this game, please browse to where you downloaded the “Setup.exe” file, double-click it, and follow on-screen instructions. If you have a CD for this game, please follow the instructions below:

1. Insert the Kawasaki Quad Bikes™ CD into your CD-ROM drive.
  - 2a. If the auto-run mode on your computer is active, the installation will start automatically. Please follow the on-screen instructions.
  - 2b. If the auto-run mode on your computer is disabled.....
    - i) Double click 'My Computer'.
    - ii) Right click your CD-ROM drive and select 'Open'.
    - iii) Double click the 'Setup.exe'.

- i) At the windows® desktop, click 'Start'.
  - ii) Select 'Run' and type the letter of your CD-ROM drive, followed by Setup.exe (e.g. D\Setup.exe)

# UNINSTALL INSTRUCTIONS

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To uninstall Kawasaki Quad Bikes™, complete the following actions:

At the windows® desktop, select:

Start → Programs → Data Design Interactive → Kawasaki Quad Bikes → Uninstall  
Kawasaki Quad Bikes.

## SETUP

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Kawasaki Quad Bikes™ is a single or 2 player game that is played using the keyboard or a gaming pad. If using a gaming pad, the pad must be connected at the time of booting the game and your control method must be selected when prompted. Analogue gaming pads are also supported to give you full freedom of movement.

## EXITING THE GAME

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To leave the game, return to the main menu and press the 'Esc' key.

## SAVING AND LOADING

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In total you can store up to 64 Kawasaki Quad Bikes™ saves. These are presented in groups of 8 located in 8 separate save folders. Upon booting the game you will be given the option of loading a previously saved game or enabling autosave for a new save file. To load a previously saved game, select the save folder containing the save file you wish to load. Then select the save file to load. If you want to start a new game, enter a save folder containing unused save files and select one of those files.

Once you have selected a new save file or loaded a previously saved game, the autosave feature will be active. Your progress will then be saved automatically.

If you choose not to load or create a new saved game at time of boot, you can do so at any time from the 'Save\Load' menu found on the 'Main Menu' screen. Enter the 'Save\Load' menu, then select whether you want to save your current game or load a previously saved game. From here, the process is the same as if you were loading or saving from boot-up.

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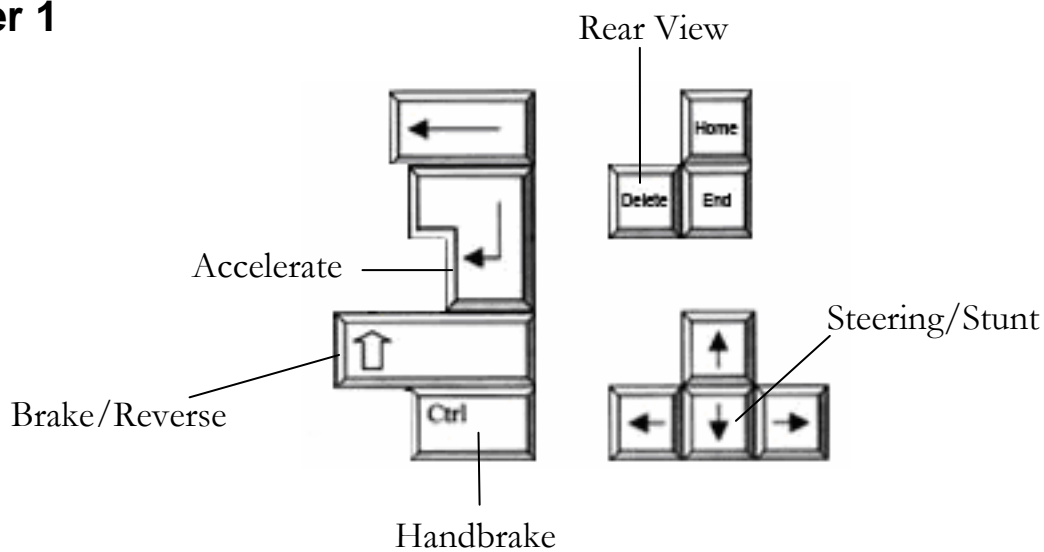
Kawasaki Quad Bikes is the ultimate quad biking experience, featuring full throttle racing directly at your fingertips.

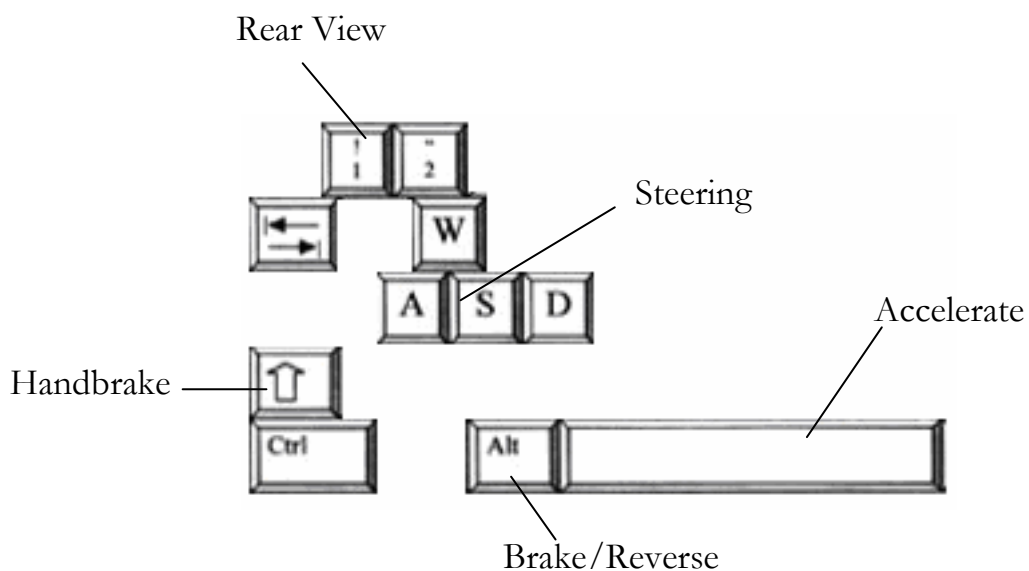
# KEYBOARD CONTROLS

To cycle through music tracks, press ' - ' key (previous track) or ' = ' key (next track)

To **pause** the game, press 'Esc' key.

# GAMING PAD CONTROLS

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When playing with a gaming pad, there is no standard control setup. This is dependant upon the type of controller that you are using and the controller setup as defined by the Windows® 'Game Controller' settings. You should use a controller with at least 5 action buttons, of which each will map to a single keyboard control.

## MAIN MENU

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**Play Game** - Upon selecting this option, you will be asked to select a difficulty setting, a game mode and a vehicle. A second player may also choose a vehicle at this stage by pressing any player 2 key (not possible in all game modes). Note, not all game options are available initially; please see the next section “unlocking” for more details on how to unlock these options.

**Options** - This menu is where you will find the game options. For further details, please see the 'Options' section of this manual.

**Save & Load** - This option will take you to the Kawasaki Quad Bikes™ load and save options. Here you can manually load or save your game progress. For further details, please see the 'Saving and Loading' section of this manual.

**Credits** – This menu is used if you want to look at the talented people at Data Design Interactive, who put Kawasaki Quad Bikes™ together. See the 'Credits' section of this manual for a more detailed breakdown.

During the Kawasaki Quad Bikes™ menus, at the very bottom of the screen exists a context sensitive 'help-bar' which shows the player how to navigate the menus. It illustrates what action will occur upon pressing each key and changes as necessary to reflect the menu status of each screen and situation.

## UNLOCKING

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‘Quad Tournament’ cups become available to play once you have won the preceding cup.

Other vehicles become available when you have earned sufficient Kredits by completing single races and cups. Your Kredits earned total is saved when you save your game.

# GAME MODES

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## Single Race

Compete in a one off race against 3 competitors. The better your finishing position, the more Kredits you will earn:

1<sup>st</sup> = K 500

2<sup>nd</sup> = K 250

3<sup>rd</sup> = K 100

4<sup>th</sup> = K 0

## Quad Tournament

Quad Tournament cups consist of three race competitions. Two of the three cups are locked initially, but will unlock in sequence when the preceding cup is won. At the end of each Race, players receive points according to their finishing position:

1<sup>st</sup> = 10 points

2<sup>nd</sup> = 8 points

3<sup>rd</sup> = 6 points

4<sup>th</sup> = 5 points

Every time one of the four stages in a cup is completed, the finishing positions are shown. The next screen displays the cumulative running total scores and cup standings so the player(s) know what they need to achieve in order to be successful overall. At the end of the cup, Kredits will be rewarded based on final standings:

1<sup>st</sup> = K 4000

2<sup>nd</sup> = K 2000

3<sup>rd</sup> = K 1000

4<sup>th</sup> = K 500

## Ghost Training

Hone your skills on the different tracks and familiarise yourself with the terrain before you attempt to challenge the best in a challenge cup. Use the ghost of your fastest lap to help you improve your times

# OPTIONS

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**How To Play** - This option takes you to a comprehensive explanation of features found in Kawasaki Quad Bikes™, what they all mean, how they affect the game and what to look out for!

**Controller** - Upon selecting this option, the player can remind himself/herself which keys do what in the game.

**Sound** - Here the user will be able to set the volume levels for music and sound FX. These settings are stored when you save your game.
